

INSTRUCTIONS FOR TEST CORRECTIONS

***No materials on your desk except a pen and a sheet of notebook paper.
On a separate sheet of paper do steps 1-4.***

1. Restate the missed question in a complete sentence.
Example: (5) The 3 branches of govt. are the executive, legislative, and judicial.
2. Analyze and note why you missed each question.
Example: A) lack of knowledge;
B) misunderstood question;
C) reading error;
D) careless mistake;
E) did not study for test;
F) did not mark an answer;
G) over-thought question;
H) narrowed, guessed, and missed.
3. After correcting all questions with the above, number the total questions you missed for each reason.
Example: 3 - lack of knowledge
2 - careless mistake
1 - reading error
4. After analyzing your total errors, state in one or two sentences what you need to do to improve on the next test.
Example: I need to study the material more and check over the test for careless errors. Read the questions more carefully.
